2 Man, 2 Ball Net, Toss Out 1 Hole per Side

“Age 65 and 16 stroke rule”

Good Morning,

Today's event is a 4 flight, 80% handicap net score event. Both players play each hole and combine their net scores for a team hole total. Teams are to toss out one hole per side (holes 1-9 and again for holes 10-18). Final score is the 2 man net total for 16 holes. If you are age 65 or older, and your scorecard shows you getting 16 strokes or more, you can use the gold tees at any time in the round. Maximum NET score on any hole for any player is double par.

The event is a Richter Cup event and points will be awarded for both participation and performance in accordance with the Richter Cup scoring system. Payouts go to top 4 places in each flight.

Please play “pick/clean/place” in your own fairway; 1 club length from original position of the ball, no closer to the hole, no improvement of lie (ex: no rough to fairway).

Failure to clear the water hazard on 3, 5, and 7: Use front of tee box for drop, OR use the drop area on the “safe side”. Please keep up with the group in front of you to ensure a good pace of play. Remember to post your score.
