

RICHTER PARK MEN'S CLUB EVENT SUSPENSION LIST

As a reminder to all RPMC members, if you sign up for an event, and then do not play, the following guidelines apply.

1. Cancellations Prior to the Day of the Event/Position Filled

*If you cancel prior to the day of the event, there will be no suspension or greens fee/cart charges as long as the spot in the field is filled.

2. Cancellations Prior to the Day of the Event/Position Unfilled

*If your position in the event is unfilled (1st offense), you are suspended from the next event and you need to reimburse RPMC for the green fees/cart charges incurred by RPMC for the unused time in order to be reinstated as an "active" player. For 2nd offense, penalty is 2 event suspension and reimbursement; 3rd offense, penalty is 3 event suspension and reimbursement. This guideline applies regardless of how much advance notice you provide. Reimbursement checks are to be sent to Gary Lehman, RPMC Treasurer, 27 Crow's Nest Lane, Unit B-4, Danbury, Ct. 06810. Reimbursements are NOT to be made to the Pro Shop or RPA.

3. Day of the Event Cancellation or "No Show"

*If you cancel or "no show" on the day of the event, and the position is unfilled, the guidelines as detailed in #2 above apply.

*If you cancel or "no show" on the day of the event, and the position is filled, you will not be billed for the greens fees/cart charges, but will be suspended from the next event.

Replacement Players

*In events that are ABCD in nature or have handicap requirements, players will be replaced with alternate roster players that have handicaps within the proper ranges.

*If none are available, players will be replaced by using players in the order that they appear on the alternate roster.

*If there is no alternate list, or time does not allow contact of the alternates, available RPMC members at the course on the day of the event will be used on a "first come, first served" basis.

The intention is to minimize the number of unused or cancelled positions in the field.

Cancellation Procedure

If you need to cancel out of an event, call either the Pro Shop or send an email notice to rpmcboard@att.net . The RPMC Board will move as fast we can to replace you, but notice to either the Pro Shop or the website does NOT necessarily mean we will find a replacement player in time. If so, your commitment to the event still stands, along with the above detailed penalties.
